Camden Campus

Southeast Georgia Health System's Camden Campus is located in St. Marys, Georgia. As a 40-bed community hospital, it provides medical, surgical, obstetrical, emergency and cancer care services to residents in the rural communities of Camden, Charlton and Brantley Counties. Camden County is the home of the Kings Bay Naval Submarine Base and the Camden Campus provides health care services to Naval Base service members and their families. The Camden Campus also serves as an integral component of disaster planning in the community.

In its 2018 Fiscal Year, the Camden Campus had more than 30,000 visits to its Emergency Department, admitted 1,976 patients for inpatient services, performed 2,690 surgical procedures and delivered 696 babies. As with most rural hospitals in Georgia, many patients presenting to the Camden Campus for care are uninsured or underinsured. As the only hospital in its primary service area, the Camden Campus provided more than \$14 million in uncompensated care in Fiscal Year 2018 and provided much needed access to primary and specialty care in the community. The Camden Campus is also a significant employer for the community and provides an annual impact of over \$94 million to the local economy.

Funds raised through the Georgia Rural Hospital Tax Credit Program will be invested in surgical equipment, a wound care center, community health programs and screenings, and staff development and training to allow the Camden Campus to continue to provide essential health care services to the community.
